



Looking for a MAJOR discovery?
Follow these steps in choosing a major!

1 KNOW THYSELF

Interests: What are your passions? Given time and resources how would you spend them?

Skills: What skills come natural? What skills have you acquired? What skills need improvement?

Personality: How would you or others describe you? In what environments are you comfortable?

Values: What is important to you (i.e. recognition, money, serving, influence, etc.?)

2 GATHER KNOWLEDGE

Explore TCU Areas of Study (<https://www.tcu.edu/academics/programs/index.php>)

Narrow down choices to 2 or 3 majors

Read course descriptions for each major in the course catalog. You should be interested in what you study!

Network with family members, friends, upper level students, alumni, and professors about majors/careers
